



How did we do?

November 2013 - January 2014

- 135 clients started new jobs
 - 76% of clients who started a job, did so in a field that uses the skills he/she gained through schooling or work experience before coming to Canada
 - 58% of clients who started a job were able to find employment at a level aligned with the job they had before coming to Canada
- The most common industry clients found employment in was Healthcare (38%); followed by Business and Finance (11%), and Other (11%). Other clients found jobs in fields including High Tech, Small Business, and Logistics.
- Of clients who secured positions related to, and aligned with, their previous experience, some careers they found include: Licensed Practical Nurse, Education Consultant, Accountant, Physiotherapist, Software Engineer, Care Aides, Chief Officer, and Marine Agent.
- 96.6% of clients would recommend the Skills Connect Program to a friend
- The overall satisfaction score of clients who responded to the survey was 93.3%
