



How did we do?

July - September 2015

- 165 clients started new jobs:
 - 62% of clients who started a job, did so in a field that uses the skills they gained through education or work experience before coming to Canada
 - 55% of clients who started a job were able to find employment at a level aligned with the job they had before coming to Canada
- The most common industry in which clients found employment include Health (24%); followed by Retail (19%), “Other” (12%), Business and Finance (12%), Hi-Tech (7%), Education (5%), and Manufacturing (5%). Other clients found jobs in Small Business, Legal, and Energy and Mining.
- Clients who secured positions related to or aligned with their previous experience include: Pharmacist, Software Developer, Physiotherapist, District Sales Manager, Registered Nurse, Network Engineer, Justice Service Worker, Veterinarian, Researcher, Accredited Business Consultant and Online Marketing Data Analyst.
- 100% of clients would recommend the Skills Connect Program to a friend
- The overall satisfaction score of clients who responded to the survey was 94.4%
